Your first report should cover all seed sales in Texas from **December 01, 2019 through February 29, 2020**. The other three quarters will end the last day of May, August and November of each year.

You must submit a report, even if you have no sales, within 30 days after the close of each quarter or a penalty will be assessed. We have included the required form needed to report your seed sales. You may duplicate this form as needed.

PERMIT TO PAY INSPECTION FEE BY REPORTING SYSTEM


